Age groups:

Those competitors who were born IN the year of 1993 or 1997 could choose age group. Please keep in mind that only one of the age groups can be chosen!

The all-against-all system of elimination will be used according to the draws. In the categories "A" competitors must perform an optional and a designated pattern (randomly chosen by the head referee). In the elimination rounds of the categories "B-C" competitors must perform designated pattern only! Those who get into the top four must perform one optional and one designated pattern. Neither of the optional nor the designated pattern could not be higher than the next pattern above the competitor's actual belt degree. (For example: 6. gup \rightarrow highest pattern can be performed is Yul-Gok tull.)

The all-against-all system of elimination will be used according to the draws. Touch contact system will be used. Fight time is $1x^2$ minutes in the elimination rounds and $2x^2$ minutes in the finals. Every competitor must wear the protective equipments according to the AETF rules. There are only weight categories for all belts.

Description of all-against-all system:

We divide the competitors of the current categories into groups of maximum five people. If the number of the competitors cannot be divided by five then there could be even five or four competitors in each group. We prepare the groups by controlled lot.

- If there will be two groups of the category (6-10 competitors), then the winners of the separated groups will be fighting for the gold and silver medals. The second bests of the groups will get the bronze medals.
- If there will be three groups of the category (11-15 competitors), then the winners of the separated groups will fight for the medals in a new all-against-all round. There will be only one bronze medal in this case.
- If there will be four groups of the category (16-20 competitors), then the winners of the separated groups will fight for the medals in a new all-against-all round. There will be two bronze medals in this case.
- Over 20 competitors the winners of the separated groups will fight for the medals in a new pyramidal system round.

<u>Pre-arranged free sparring:</u> Junior and senior categories.

The set up of the pairs could be optional: woman-woman, man-man, woman-man. The competition will take place in two separated rounds. In the first round all the pairs perform their sparring and they get a score for it. The best four will perform the sparring again. The first pair will be the opponent of the third one and the second pair will be the opponent of the fourth one. From this point the pyramid system of elimination will be used. At the beginning of the competition the order of the pairs will be decided by lot. Duration of the sparring: minimum 50 seconds – maximum 75 seconds.



TEAM categories:

Age groups:	Those competitors who were born IN the year of 1993 could choose age group between junior OR senior. Please keep in mind that only one of these two can be chosen!

The competition will take place in two separated rounds. In the first round the teams must perform the designated pattern. The first four team with the highest scores will be qualified to the finals. The first team will be the opponent of the third one and the second team will be the opponent of the fourth one. From this point the pyramid system of elimination will be used. In the finals teams must perform one optional pattern only (this could be the designated as well). Optional pattern could be Ge-Baek tull maximum or that pattern which is one level above the degree of the team member with the highest belt degree.

The pyramid system of elimination will be used according to the draws. Touch contact system will be used. Fight time is 1x2 minutes. Every competitor must wear the protective equipments according to the AETF rules. Every match worth 2 points for the winner team and every match resulted in a draw worth 1-1 point for both team.

Referees:	The referees of the Hungarian ITF Taekwon-do federation and the referees of the invited clubs. Referees have to wear the official dress. We would like to ask you to secure min. one referee per club: 1 – 10 competitors – club has to provide min. one referee, if not, the penalty is 30 Euro. Over 10 competitors – club has to provide min. two umpires, if not, the penalty is 60 Euro.
